


#### Summary of the 1st day




## Pupils composition in Estonia, 2013/2014




### **Target groups**

### **Current challenges**

- **1. Lack of clear definitions** of target groups
- 2. Insufficient data on returnees
- **3. Uneven level of preparedness among schools** to educate pupils, while addressing diversity and individual differences
- 4. Teacher **pre-service training model does not include systematic preparation** for working with diverse pupils
- 5. Teachers' in-service training is incoherent
- **6. Cooperation** within and between various levels of education **is unsystematic**
